Story from the community



Aslam Masih and his Wife Shakila Bibi are living in the village Dullam (Chak 325 JB), Toba Tek Singh. They have 3 children, a girl and two boys. The girls name is Fiza Aslam, 6 years old, and she wants to become a teacher (like her school teacher). The boys name is Narosh Aslam, 4 years old, and he wants to become a doctor. One is boy is one and half years old.

Two of their children are studying in our Joy Foundation School. Their house is a big empty plot with 2 trees in it, only one room, one kitchen and a washroom in it. Alam Masih is the only earning hand in the family and is working as a laborer in the city and earns very less. His wife is now getting training in our Sewing Centre and will soon after completing her training will help her husband in the income of family. They are happy that they have school in village which is free for their children and their children are happy to getting education in their own village.

Child Sponsorship Program



Case Study

Joy Foundation has been sponsoring Vishal Jamal since 2012. Vishal was in class 2 when we started sponsoring him. From many years Vishal lost his father and her mother is the only bird winner of the family. Because of this entire situation Vishal's mother was not able to afford his educational expenses as they were poor and Vishal was studying in a private school. Thereon Joy Foundation decided to sponsor Vishal. His yearly fees, expenses of books, school bag and stationary, water bottle and lunch box all of his educational expenses are being covered by Joy Foundation. Now he is studying in 6th grade in the same private school. His family is very thankful to Joy Foundation for supporting their son. Vishal said, without Joy Foundation I would not have reached here, I thanks Joy Foundation for providing me assistance and support to continue my education. All these years Vishal has been a very good student and Joy Foundation is proud to sponsor him.





Joy Foundation child sponsorship program is a continuous project since 2009. Under this project joy foundation sponsors those children whose parents can't afford their education expenses. Every year new children are added to this program.22 children were being supported by this program in 2018 and this year Joy Foundation added 2 new children. Now Joy Foundation is sponsoring 24 children through its child sponsorship program. We believe we make a living by what we get, but we make a life with what we give, our slight positive influence has the potential to change child's life, SO providing opportunities to our future is what Joy Foundation takes stand for.

"Peaceful Co- Existence among the Religious Communities"

The Christian study centre (CSC) Rawalpindi is an organization that has been working to promote interfaith dialogue peace and harmony in the country. Christian Study Centre initiated the project on "Peaceful co-existence among the Religion Communities" in four districts of Punjab Pakistan from January 2011-march 2013 in the four areas of district Faisalabad (Jhumra, Tandlianwala, Samundri and Jaranwala) and later from April 2014-December 2016 two other Tehsil is added which Tehsil Nankana Sahib and Tehsil Gojra

After that in the next phase was initiated in January 2017.in this phase Christian Study Centre expanded its project area to Toba Tek Singh .It is a three year project (2017-2019) titled peaceful Co-existence among religious Communities. It is the third phase of the project. Before starting the project CSC visited all the organizations in Toba Tek Singh and selected five organizations as partners for this project and Joy Foundation was also selected by CSC among these five partners.

After selection of the partners CSC organized a TOT for all five partner organizations in Rawalpindi and a follow up meeting was conducted after three months. The partners provided stakeholders for the training which will support the partners and CSC for this project in Toba Tek Singh. CSC along with their partner organizations gave trainings to religious leaders, women and youth leaders, social activists and journalists. In 2019 all the partners organized different activities with the great support of CSC. We also formed two peace committees, one in city Toba Tek Singh and the other in Tehsil Pirmahal.

Peace Committee Meeting

Christian Study Centre Rawalpindi in collaboration with 5 partner organizations (including Joy Foundation) in Toba Tek Singh formed the Peace Committee at local level. The members of the Peace Committee included decision-makers, educationists, poets, community leaders and members from civil society organizations. The deep-rooted nature of conflict at local level, the psychological effects of violence and neglect on local communities where protagonists had to continue co-existing, the prospect of intense political competition in the context of a fragile peace, and the dynamics and inherent instability of transition periods provided sufficient reasons for considering the implementation of Peace Committees at local level. . The members of the Peace Committee included decision-makers, educationists, poets, community leaders and members from civil society organizations. A meeting was organized by the staff of CSC and cluster organizations in which the members for the committee were selected and the agenda of the formation of the peace committee was shared by Madam Fahmida Saleem (Program Manager, CSC).





"One day Workshop on building the capacity of today's young peace leaders"

Joy Foundation organized a youth capacity building program with the young people of district Toba Tek Singh with the support of Christian study Center Rawalpindi and all partner organization at Dee Paradise hotel Toba on 25 of September 2019. Mr. Shahid (NCJP Faisalabad), Mr. Sajid Manzoor from Faisalabad, Mr. Yaqoob Sadiq (Director Joy Foundation and Mrs. Fahmida Saleem were the resource person.

The program started with prayer. Pastor Irfan shared words of God from the Bible and Qari Arshad read from the holy Quran. After this Mr. Yaqoob Sadiq (Director, JF) gave the introduction of Joy Foundation and briefly explained the purpose of the program. Mr. Irfan Naz (Program Coordinator, CSC) gave introduction of Christian study center and also shared the objective of the project.

Mr. Shahid from NCJP started his first session on Human Rights & Peace building. Through his multimedia presentation he gave the whole introduction of Human Rights and also shares about the Universal declaration of Human rights. He made his session more participatory with the youth. He also had some group activities with the participants on Human Rights & peace building. The entire participants enjoy his session and learn many new things.

Mr. Sajid Manzoor from Faisalabad started his sessions on the topic of Peace building skills. He shares many examples of interfaith harmony from the community with youth. He also shared many new skills of peace building. He made the session more participatory and tried to involve the participant.

After this Mr. Yaqoob Sadiq starts his session on Role of Youth for the Promotion of Peaceful Co-existence. He said that if we want a better and brighter future we have to empower and improve our youth and encourage them to take better decisions and make education their priority. He said that we being the youth and the tomorrow of our nation have to prove that we have the ability to bring change in our communities; we have to step out and change the old phenomenon, where youth have no idea what to do after completing their matriculation/where they have to forcibly act upon the decisions of their family or friends. Let's take decisions by ourselves instead of following others and see what is better for us and our future.

At the end of the program Mrs. Fahmida Saleem concluded the sessions. She appreciated the team of Joy Foundation and also thanked all the partner organizations which are supporting Christian Study Center for this project of Interfaith Harmony and peace building. She also thanked the entire resource persons who shared meaningful information with youth. She said that now is the time for youth to play an important role to create a peaceful society. At the end Mrs. Shazia Yaqoob thanked all the participants, partner organization, resource persons and team of Christian Study Center.















Water, Hygiene & Sanitation Program(WASH)







Lack of good toilets and hygiene education is a big problem in rural communities in Toba Tek Singh. Joy Foundation planned a project to construct toilets in the target community especially for girls and women to reduce diarrhea related illnesses by 25% to 50%. This project is not only for the girls and women it's also for the whole family as well.

Joy Foundation constructs 10 toilets that will serve over 60 individuals including 45% girls and women, for over 15 years. Joy Foundation selects Chak No. 327 which has no access to good toilets. The people defecated just behind their houses in the open fields. Joy Foundation selected 10 families and constructed the toilets in their home. At the same time Joy Foundation realized they needed water to use in the Toilets so Joy Foundation provided 10 hand pumps to the target families to use the water for their toilets to make it clean. This project is very important for the community especially for the girls and women.
